- **Subscribers:** You need at least 1,000 subscribers.
- **Watch Hours:** You need 4,000 valid public watch hours in the past 12 months.

Think of watch hours as the total time people spend watching your content. So, 4,000 hours means people have watched your videos for that long overall. The number of views needed to reach 4,000 watch hours will vary depending on the length of your videos.

For example:

- If your videos are 10 minutes long, you'd need roughly 240 videos watched fully to reach 4,000 watch hours (4,000 minutes / 10 minutes per video = 400 videos).
- If your videos are 5 minutes long, you'd need around 480 videos watched fully.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is a high number of views always better? A higher number of views is generally beneficial, as it can lead to more watch hours and potential earnings. However, focusing on quality content that keeps viewers engaged for longer is more important than simply chasing views.

What counts as a valid watch hour? A valid watch hour is time spent watching a publicly available video. Views from private or unlisted videos don't count. Also, repeated views from the same user within a short period might not all be counted.

How do I get more watch hours? Creating engaging content is key! Promote your videos on social media, collaborate with other creators, and use relevant keywords in your titles and descriptions.

Can I get paid with fewer than 4,000 watch hours? Unfortunately, no. The 4,000 watch hour requirement is a firm rule for joining the Youtube Partner Program and monetizing your channel.
